**AN RESOLUTION TO CREATE A TRAYVON WILKENS MEMOMIAL PEDESTRIAN
FUND AMENDING TITLE 1, ADMINISTRATION, CHAPTER 8, BUDGET OF THE
CITY CODE OF ORDINANCES TO RESTRICT SCHOOL ZONE TRAFFIC CAMERA
REVENUES FOR PEDESTRIAN SAFETY IMROVEMENTS AND FOR OTHER
LAWFUL PURPOSES**

(Sponsored by Councilperson khalid)

Plain Text Explanation: All money generated from tickets written by traffic cameras will spent on speed bumps, sidewalks, cross walks and other pedestrian safety projects.

WHEREAS, the City of South Fulton (“City”) is a municipal corporation duly organized and existing under the laws of the State of Georgia;

WHEREAS, the duly elected governing authority of the City is the Mayor and Council thereof (“City Council”);

WHEREAS, the City desires to amend its code of ordinance through this Ordinance to support successful code enforcement operations by ensuring said operation are properly funded; and

WHEREAS, this Ordinance is in the best interests of the health and general welfare of the City, its residents and general public.

WHEREAS, creating pedestrian-safe, walkable communities that increase commerce and reduce racial health disparities is a top priority for Ordinance is in the best interests of the health and general welfare of the City, its residents and general public.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SOUTH FULTON HEREBY ORDAINS as follows:

Section 1. It is hereby ordained by the City Council that Title 1, Administration, Chapter 8, Code Enforcement, **Section 1-8003, Municipal Budget Policy**, is hereby amended to read as:

TITLE 1. - ADMINISTRATION

Chapter 8. - Budget

....

Sec. 1-8003 – Municipal Budget Policy

- (i) One hundred percent of all fines, fees, and judgments resulting from Traffic Camera Enforcement, minus Contracting and Municipal Court costs, shall be allocated by the City Finance Officer to a **Restricted Fund** for Pedestrian Safety Projects. This fund shall be used, as directed by the Public Works Director, towards designing, constructing, fixing, repairing, maintaining, protecting, managing, acquiring right of ways and/or taking other necessary action to install, maintain and/or repair speed bumps, speed tables, cross walks, sidewalks and/or taking other necessary projects to maintain or improve pedestrian safety.
- (j) Current subsections (i, j, k) shall be renumbered to (j, k, l).

Section 2. It is hereby declared to be the intention of the City Council that: (a) All sections, paragraphs, sentences, clauses and phrases of this Ordinance are or were, upon their enactment, believed by the City Council to be fully valid, enforceable and constitutional.

(b) To the greatest extent allowed by law, each and every section, paragraph, sentence, clause or phrase of this Ordinance is severable from every other section, paragraph, sentence, clause or phrase of this Ordinance. No section, paragraph, sentence, clause or phrase of this Ordinance is mutually dependent upon any other section, paragraph, sentence, clause or phrase of this Resolution.

(c) In the event that any phrase, clause, sentence, paragraph or section of this Ordinance shall, for any reason whatsoever, be declared invalid, unconstitutional or otherwise unenforceable by the valid judgment or decree of any court of competent jurisdiction, it is the express intent of the City Council that such invalidity, unconstitutionality or unenforceability shall, to the greatest extent allowed by law, not render invalid, unconstitutional or otherwise unenforceable any of the remaining phrases, clauses, sentences, paragraphs or sections of the Ordinance.

Section 3. All Ordinance and Resolutions in conflict herewith are hereby expressly repealed.

Section 4. The City Attorney, City Clerk and contracted City Codifier are authorized to make non-substantive formatting and renumbering edits to this ordinance for proofing, codification, and supplementation purposes. The final version of all ordinances shall be filed with the clerk.

Section 5. The effective date of this Ordinance shall be on the date as set forth under Sec. 3.21 of the City Charter unless provided otherwise by applicable local, state and/or federal law.
