Call Taker Process For Curbside Service

- Residents must register no later than Monday, April 5, 2021
 - Registration will be logged under the “Clean Up Day” category in SeeClickFix
 - Residents will need to provide their street address, cell number and email address
 - Confirmations will be sent via email once the resident is registered in SeeClickFix (Note: No confirmation calls will be made)
- To qualify for this service, the caller must be a resident of the City of South Fulton and at least 65 years of age or legally disabled
- Approved materials should be placed on the curb Friday, April 9th for pickup on Saturday, April 10th

Items Prohibited From Curbside Service Collection:

- Riding lawn mowers
- Construction debris (anything attached, glued or tied down in a home)
- Documents for shredding
- Household trash
- Appliances
- Paint can be collected if the top has been removed and the container has been dried out (permissible to fill with cat litter or dirt and let dry for 7 days)



DEFINITIONS

Construction Debris: Any item that was attached, glued or tied down in a building or home (i.e. carpet, sheet rock, shingles, bathtubs, etc.).

Bulky Items: Any large or oversized household item that is not intended to be attached to a wall or floor (i.e. sofa, throw rug, table, television, computer, appliance, etc.).
